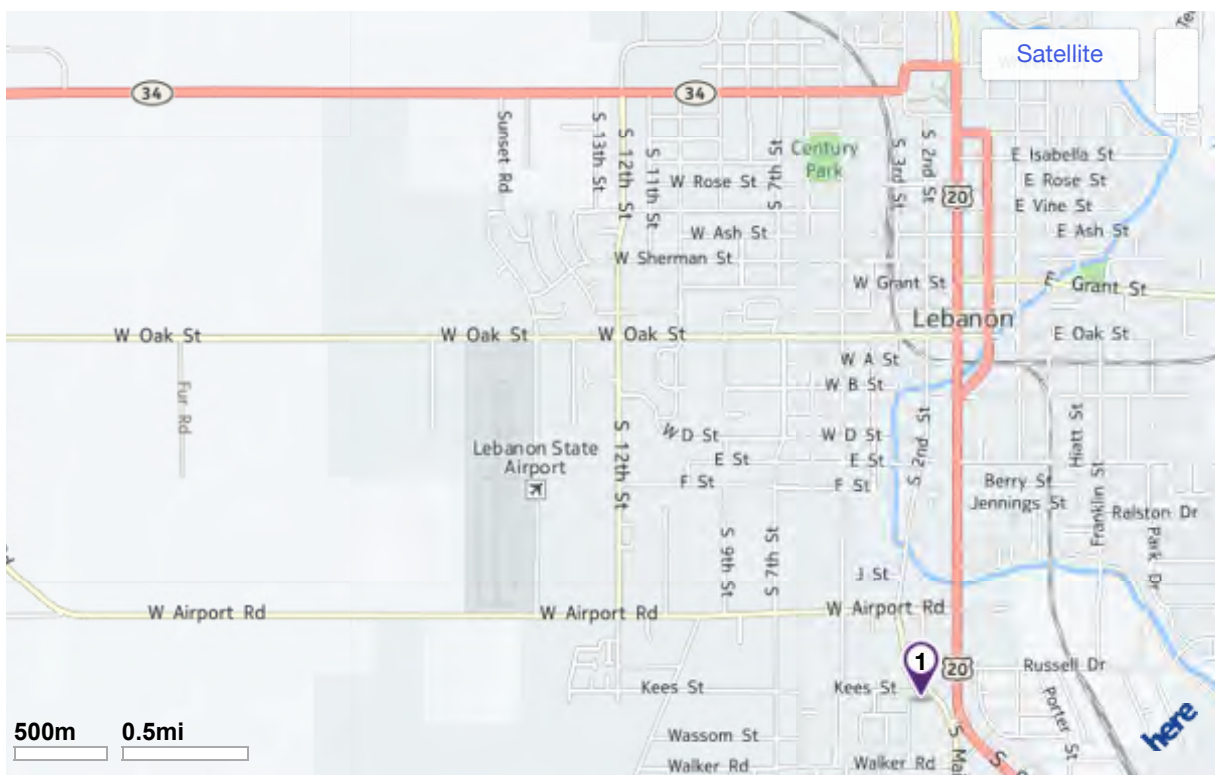

Membership:

Under 55 - \$10.00/year

Senior/Over 55 - \$7.00/year

A = Please fill out the form on the back. Please write your name and address – we confirm your identity with our last year's records. When you pay for your membership, please confirm your membership. If we do not have your address, your membership will not be processed.

B = You can pay from January 1st to March 28th. We are giving you two (2) days to renew by mail so that your completed form can arrive in our mailbox on March 31st. It is a flat rate per year. If you pay now before January 1st then you are good until next January 1st.

C = We accept cash and money orders. **Money orders must be made out to Deaf Services of Southern Oregon.**
